MRCP: Music Rack Control Panels



Description

The Classic Organ Works Music Rack Control Panel is the answer to space problems on a large organ console. Requiring only an inch of height, it mounts beneath a normal music rack and houses those displays and controls which would normally be in one or more control panels on the jambs or backboard.





There are three versions which differ only in the quantity of bargraph displays for expression shoes. The MRCP-1 has 5 bargraphs, the MRCP-2 (shown above) has 3 while the MRCP-3 has 4. The bargraphs may have multicoloured segments if required (to clearly show maximum settings).

Either side of the bargraphs are rows of 8 momentaryaction, illuminated push-buttons which can be used for the Classic system controls or for special functions. Pushbutton lamps may be red, yellow or green.

Outside each row of push-buttons are two multi-digit numerical displays for Memory Level, Registration Sequencer stage, Transposer stage and Crescendo shoe stage.

Beneath the left side is a dimming control which is common to all the lamps and displays.

Because there can be so many variations in the pushbutton functions and displays, each MRCP is custom-built. There is space to add extra indicator lamps near the ends.

Features

- Collects all controls and displays into one location for ease of access.
- Forms the base of a music rack.
- o Contains 3, 4 or 5 expression-shoe bargraphs.
- o Has 4 sets of multi-digit numerical displays.
- o 2 rows of 8 momentary-action push-buttons.
- \circ All displays and lamps are a restful green.
- All displays and lamps are dimmable.Single small cable to CCU in console.
- o Serial-only control via standard DB-9 plug.
- o Removes as an open working unit for service.
- o Same length as a keyboard.
- o Minimum height.

Applications

Ideal for retrofitting to existing (large) consoles where space is limited, the Music Rack Control Panel includes all the control push-buttons, numeric displays, and bargraph displays in a compact unit that becomes the base of a music rack. All the displays are dimmable.
