OrganWorks™ Software

OrganWorks™ is the world's most popular organ-design program. Since its first release at the 1995 AIO convention, the program has been downloaded by thousands of organ builders, organists, and organ enthusiasts in more than 60 countries around the world!

OrganWorks™ is a Microsoft Windows™-based program which allows an organ builder, organ salesperson, or organist to specify requirements for an organ. It provides a simplified way to specify all the complex technical data required by the Classic engineering department to design and build the organ's control system. It allows you, the organbuilder or consultant, to depict the layout of an organ console for the benefit of the organ selection committee.

Information about the organ is entered primarily on a graphical presentation of the organ console on the computer screen. Components (such as drawknobs, pistons, etc.) can be selected from a palette, and placed on the console. The size of the console, stop jambs, etc. can be adjusted to accommodate the number of stops, keyboards, etc., desired. Pop-up windows allow the user to enter all the information necessary to specify the details of each component as it is specified. The computer continually checks for errors or conflicting information, and also can provide an error/warning report by simply clicking on the "Diagnostics" icon. A new project "Wizard" helps you enter the basic organ information quickly and easily.

An enormous amount of information about the organ can be specified, including everything about the console (keyboards, stops, couplers, pistons, toe studs, displays, expression shoes, and other controls) and also full chamber information (chambers, chests, pipe ranks, swell engines, tremulants,

electronic stops, percussions, MIDI-stops, etc.).

The program provides a number of reports and drawings. These include console drawings, and a summary of the organ's specifications (stop list, features list, technical info, chamber chest & rank info, with cross-reference to stops, etc.).

Included on the program disk is a comprehensive help file, the "Organist's Reference Manual", a tutorial and a "Catalog on Disk" describing the Classic Pipe Organ Control System and many of its components; all in easy to use Windows Help (or HTML) format.

The program is downloadable and fully supported at WWW.ORGANWORKS.COM. There, you will find new and updated versions periodically, technical support information, answers to frequently asked questions, tips, and additional examples of finished OrganWorks project files.

The unregistered version of the OrganWorks program is available free of charge. You may download it, or we would be happy to send it to you on a CD. If you find the program useful, you may register it. When you register it, you receive a code from Classic Organ Works that unlocks the printing features and allows you to personalize printed output by adding your company name, etc. The cost to register is only \$40(US) or \$60(CDN), cash, cheque, or VISA.
